



Range Expansion of Shrub Thickets on Virginia Barrier Islands



Shrub thicket is a major vegetation type on barrier islands. False color aerial photographs were used to generate vegetation databases for three barrier islands of Virginia. GIS packages ERDAS & ARC/INFO were used to interprete the aerial photographs and to analyze shrub distributions. Two common features for the shrub spreading on the three islands have been identified: 1) the island portion where shrub thickets were spreading is wider than before, and 2) 95 percent of new shrub thickets were regenerated from where dense grasses had been previously distributed.
